

Investment Philosophy and Approach

TD Epoch's investment philosophy is centered on the belief that the generation and allocation of free cash flow represents the best predictor of shareholder return. The TD Epoch U.S. Small Cap Quality Value strategy pursues long term capital appreciation by investing in a portfolio of 60 to 90 small-capitalization U.S. companies. As fundamental investors with a long-term orientation, we select companies based on their ability to generate free cash flow and allocate it intelligently for the benefit of shareholders. Our bottom-up security selection process is balanced with diversification and risk control measures that should result in below average portfolio volatility.

Our investment process begins by identifying candidates for investment from a universe of common stocks generally consisting of companies in the Russell 2000 Index, although the strategy has the flexibility to invest outside the Index. From the investable universe, the we develop a focused list of investment candidates sourced by our qualitative insights, quantitative tools, and macroeconomic observations. Analysts leverage their deep industry knowledge and experience to identify potential research candidates. We complement our fundamental insights with the Epoch Core Model, a proprietary quantitative tool that expresses and reinforces, in quantitative terms, the economic logic behind Epoch's fundamental research.
